Who We Are

Under the patronage of our Lady of Joyful Hope and St. Clare, St. Clare's Home is a maternity home for those women who find themselves in a crisis pregnancy with no place to go and seemingly no other options. We are opening the home to women over the age of eighteen and also will accommodate their already born children. Through our research, it is women in this age group who have the most need of assistance. The home can accommodate up to eight women.

What We Believe

It is the right of every pregnant woman to give birth, and the right of every child to be born. "Under the patronage of Our Lady of Joyful Hope, we will provide a home for women experiencing crisis pregnancy, and through loving direction, help them gain the life skills needed to support themselves and their children."



What We Offer

St Clare's is operating two locations, in South Carolina, to better serve the needs of moms in crisis. St. Clare's Home offers a safe, loving atmosphere in a home-like setting, where pregnant mothers are offered classes on pregnancy, childbirth, and life skills such as parenting, financial management, and nutrition. Mothers will be required to attend some form of higher education or will have to maintain a job while in the home. In the home we have:

- Eight, fully-furnished bedrooms
- Full-sized kitchen
- Large dining room
- Chapel
- Living area with a fireplace
- Children's playground outside
- Large front and back porch with rocking chairs

Our Staff & Volunteers

We employ religious sisters at both locations, who have experience in health care and social work, a volunteer coordinator and shift supervisors. We hope volunteers will provide additional assistance to meet the needs of the mothers.
